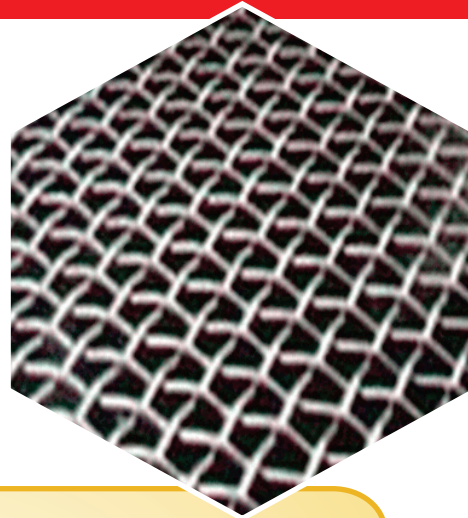


Knitted success through wire Knittter
